Corona Virus COVID-19 Directives,  
Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

- 1) President bans all private motor vehicle, announces prohibition of all Movement starting 10pm tonight. Diplomats can use their cars to visit shopping centers, hospitals and back home. Key workers including media should continue using their cars but with stickers as provided by ministry of works.
- 2) all Arcades are banned from operating for 14 Days
- 3) all Non food shops and stores are all Restricted for 14 a days.
- 4) Shopper Market should remain open but with strict standard operating procedure.
- 5) Established food market should continue to be opened however with a distance of 2 meters.
- 6) Saloons, Lodges should also be closed for 14 Days.
- 7) Social service like banks, telecom, petrol stations, medical services, UNRA, URA and Funeral services should continue operating.
- 8) Cargo Transport by Lorry, Train, and Tukutuku with in Uganda must continue with a maximum of 3 Persons.
- 9) Gathering of more than 5 people is Prohibited. Scientific weddings of not more than 10 people can continue.
- 10) There is curfew beyond 7pm.
- 11) Transporting of Mother's going to give birthday should seek Permission from the RDC.
- 12) Government to discuss with Banks on loans, water and electricity.
- 13) Government workers should also stay at Home. Only those with in critical offices can be able to access offices
- 14) Families of police and soldiers should also be restricted on movement.

15) Government is to distribute Food to the drivers and those who work on casual basis, they will be given Posho, Milk, Bean and Sugar.
